Philodendron				Forgiving with lack of water, fast-growing
Snake Plant		$\bullet \bullet \circ \circ \circ$	•0000	Good for lower light conditions
ZZ Plant			•0000	Good for lower light conditions
Monstera				Enjoys consistent watering schedule
Syngonium				Easy-going, good for leca medium
Anthurium				Slow-growing, high humidity
Scindapsus				Water when leaves curl
Dracaena				Hardy, can tolerate lower light conditions
Umbrella Plant				Hardy, avoid direct light

Ficus				Doesn't like to be moved around
Begonia			••••	Good for terrariums, leaves like to be dry
lvy			$\bullet \bullet \circ \circ \circ$	Keep soil consistently moist
Tradescantia				Prune to maintain fullness
Peperomia •				Delicate stems, pinch off blooms
Hoya				Slow-growing, water when leaves fold
Spider Plant				Avoid direct light
Cactus		•0000	•0000	Direct light, bottom water only
Orchid				Use orchid fertilizer, prone to root rot

Aglaonema				Prone to root rot, doesn't like drafts
Peace Lily				Keep soil consistently moist
Aloe Vera		$\bullet \bullet \circ \circ \circ$	•0000	Treat this plant like a cactus
Dieffenbachia •				Keep soil consistently moist
Kalanchoe			•0000	Acts like a succulent, but needs more water
Oxalis				Water when plant droops
Prayer Plant				Water when leaves curl
Hard	LIGHT	WATER	HUMIDITY	NOTES
Cissus			••••	Keep soil consistently moist
Fern		••••	••••	Good for terrariums
Alocasia				High humidity, avoid direct light
Croton				Prone to spider mites
Calathea				Prone to spider mites
Pilea				Good for leca medium, sensitive
Succulents		$\bullet \bullet \circ \circ \circ$	\bullet	Holds moisture, prone to root rot
African Violet				Keep leaves dry & soil consistently moist
String of Pearls			•0000	Bottom water when pearls are deflated
String of Hearts			•0000	Bottom water when leaves fold
